

## IMMUNISATION REQUIREMENTS

Attention Parents and Guardians,

Regulations have been made under the Public Health Act 2016 (WA), to strengthen requirements around the collection and reporting of immunisation information by child care services, kindergartens and schools. At enrolment and re-enrolment, the parent/guardian of child is required to give the Immunisation status of the child as recorded on the child's current immunisation certificate at time of enrolment.

The only acceptable documentation for this purpose is the child's Immunisation History Statement (IHS) from the Australian Immunisation Register (AIR) or your online Mygov - Medicare Account.

The date of the statement can not be older than 2 months at time of Enrolment.

A current Immunisation History Statement (IHS) can be obtained by the parent/guardain through:

- \*Myggov, by logging into your Medicare Account
- \*Medicare Express App
- \* Visiting a Medicare Centrelink office
- \*Calling the AIR General Enquiries line on 1800 653 809 for the Statement to be posted.

Families who do not hold a Medicare card are advised to call AIR on 1800 653 809 to request an immunisation. Parents are automatically sent an AIR Immunisation History Statement once their child turns 18 months of age and then at 5 years of age or after their child has completed the 4 year old vaccination schedule, whichever comes first. For translating and interpreting services, parents/guardians Are advised to call 131 450.
